The average life expectancy for the population of Malawi is late 30s. The risks to life of mother and baby in childbirth are enormous, and significantly heightened if an instrumental delivery or caesarean section is required. The operating theatre now being put together will greatly improve the chances of survival for countless women and their babies, and patients generally. €200,000+ is required to fit out and complete the unit to working order. The plan is to have it in place and 'operational' by April 2011.
